## R.E. NEWS

The beginning of Advent marked the start of a new liturgical year, which marks the transition of the Lectionary cycle for the readings from Year A to Year B to Year C. These cycles are a result of the Second Vatican Council, which ordered a change in the Sunday readings at Mass so that Catholics would become more familiar with the text of the Bible.

As a result, we have a 3-year cycle built around the 3 synoptic gospels – Matthew, Mark and Luke. We are currently in Year C with the readings of Luke.

Each of the four Biblical accounts of Jesus' ministry, death and resurrection brings with it a unique perspective of who Jesus was and what he was about.

Luke's goal is to inspire in Christ's followers a faithfulness to their commitment based on God's fidelity to them. He does this by reminding the hearer/reader of God's past faithfulness and drawing attention to parallels in the present. This instills hope and trust in the promises yet to be fulfilled, including the return of Jesus and the redemption of Israel. Luke's is the only gospel to call Jesus 'Saviour' and salvation is a prominent theme but unlike Mark and Matthew who link salvation to Jesus' death on the cross, Luke shows Jesus saving people throughout his ministry. And today salvation is happening in their midst: "Today this scripture has been fulfilled", "Today salvation has come to this house", "Today you will be with me in

Pick Up times during Covid: 2:30pm Kindy, Year 1 and Siblings 2:45pm Year 2—6




#### Thank You P & F Helpers!



#### **Anaphylaxis**

At St Bernadette's each year there are a number of children who experience anaphylaxis – in particular a severe allergic reaction when they are exposed to peanuts and nut related products. If



those children are exposed to these foods a severe allergic reaction can occur within 20 minutes of exposure and can rapidly become life threatening. Accidental exposure to these foods can happen at eating times and in the case of one of our students, the allergic reaction can be triggered when another person has touched or eaten these foods and then that person touches them. As a community we can assist these children by making our school environment safe. We ask families to:

- NOT use peanut, nut and chocolate spreads when making and sending sandwiches to school.
- remind children NOT to share their food with other children at school
- explain to your children the seriousness of food allergies for those children who are affected by them and that we can help to keep these children safe by the choices we make.
