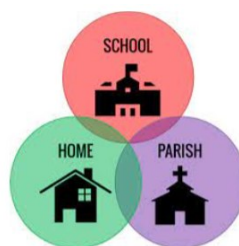
## R.E. NEWS



Children from our parish and school community who are preparing to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation will be presented to the Parish at a Commitment Ceremony this weekend.

Sacramental initiation is parish-oriented. Introduction to the Church's sacramental life is the means through which one enters more fully into the life of the faith community. It is therefore proper that the faith community, expressed in the parish, be responsible for and intimately involved in, the sacramental preparation and presentation of children.

The progressive introduction of children to the sacraments includes discernment of their readiness, which is not simply a matter of age. Priest and parents both have a role in ascertaining that the child has achieved appropriate faith development, and that adequate faith support is assured. Please keep the children in your prayers as they prepare for their Reconciliation.

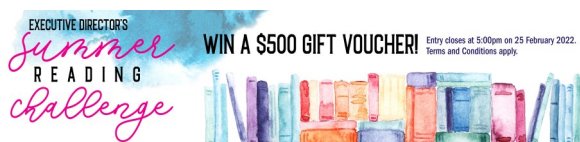
