

When we think about a year we often think of it in terms of its seasons. Each season has its particular feel, its own customs and activities that we associate with it. We adapt or change according to the season.

Our life journey too, can be viewed using the image of seasons. We experience seasons in the physical, social, emotional and spiritual aspects of our lives. A calendar year



The Liturgical Year is similar in the way it is organised. It provides particular occasions and whole seasons to ritualize the significant movements in our Christian life. It is through this cyclical process that the Church renews itself again and again. In the Liturgical Year every season or feast day has its own unique symbols and colour which help us to explore and be involved in the mystery of the incarnation, birth, life, death and resurrection of Jesus.

We begin the Liturgical Year on the First Sunday of Advent then move to Christmas, Ordinary Time, Lent, Triduum or Three Days, Easter, Pentecost and Ordinary Time again, finishing with the feast of Christ the King. The liturgical seasons provide us with a way of looking at the same mystery from different aspects in order to learn something new each time we experience them. Year after year it invites us to deepen our relationship with Jesus.

The different colours are drawn from creation to remind those participating in a liturgy of the different blessings of God. The colours used are white (or gold), purple (or violet), green, red and rose pink.
