#### **Project Compassion 2022**

Funds from Project Compassion will help people like 12-year-old Anatercia from Mozambique to break the cycle of poverty and forge a brighter future.

Mind Full, or Mindful?

This week in our wellbeing lessons we look at being mindful. Mindfulness is a skill that keeps our minds healthy. Mindfulness is noticing and being curious about what is happening right now. It helps us control our thoughts.

#### Kindergarten, Year 1 and 2

Students this week looked at all the different types of families. We read a story about what is important to a family and whatever type of family you belong to, the love that is shared is the same.

#### Years 3 and 4

A lot of things in our lives change as we get older, such as our physical appearance, social skills and our interests. This can be exciting! Sometimes it is scary. Stage 2 shared some changes that they have experienced and discussed the strategies they could use to help them cope. Moving house, school or even country, the birth of a new sibling or the loss of a Grandparent were some of the changes they shared.

#### Years 5 and 6

This week we discussed mindfulness and how it helps our wellbeing. Practicing mindfulness means we are focused, which helps when we are performing tasks. Mindfulness can also help relieve stress. We talked about how many of our thoughts are negative and discussed how important it is to have positive self-talk.

#### **Covid News**

No doubt you have read in the media all about the easing of COVID restrictions.

This is welcome news and we look forward to school life returning to normal. Here are some details relevant to us at St Bernadette's as of Monday 28th February, where we can revert to many of our usual practices.

- Break times- Recess 10:30am, Lunch 1:00pm- all grades to have breaks at the same time.
- Student Arrival time- before 8:30am with supervision from 8am. Please continue to use the kiss and drop area in the carpark or Brisbane Rd gates.

   Parents not to enter the school gates in the morning at this time so that we can establish proper school routines. We will keep you updated as changes are made.
- Dismissal time- 2:45pm for all grades
- Blue Wall pick up- 3:00pm-3:15pm for all grades. Please DO NOT line up for pick up before this time.
- Tuckshop Terrace Pick up- 2:45pm-3pm for all grades. If you wish to pick your child up in person inside the school gate, you must park your car in the top carpark, walk to the area outside the canteen and your child will walk up to meet you. You then need to exit the school and carpark quickly to enable Blue Wall pick up to commence at 3pm. Parents must not walk to classrooms or elsewhere in the school. Parents are encouraged to wear a face mask if unable to maintain social distancing from other parents.
- Brisbane Rd, Old Northern Road, Buses- 2:45pm for all grades
- After school care- no changes
- **Crunch'n'sip** is still strongly encouraged for all grades
- Canteen- open for lunches daily, closed for recess orders and sales for the moment. Online ordering of lunches is recommended.
- Uniform Shop- online orders to continue
- **Library** borrowing begins! Please ensure your child brings their library bag to school
- PE/Dance Fever- days remain the same
- RAT kits and testing- remain at the discretion of the parents. As always, if your child is sick keep them home and it is strongly recommended that you complete a RAT or PRC test. Please continue to follow NSW Health requirements and notify the school if your child or a close family member contracts COVID.
- Face Masks- mandatory for staff for 1 more week, optional for children
- If pick up arrangements are changing for your child, please notify your child's class teacher in writing.
