Sunday is Pentecost Sunday.

Pentecost always falls 50 days after Easter. It celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the Virgin Mary. It is often called

'the birthday of the Church'. The disciples of Jesus were waiting to receive the Holy Spirit because that is what Jesus told them would happen. Just before He was taken up to heaven he told them that they would receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on them and they would be his witnesses in the whole world (Acts 1:8).

The disciples and other Christians had come together to thank God and suddenly a sound like the blowing of a strong wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were singing.

Next, they saw tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. When the tongues of fire came they were filled with the Holy Spirit and the disciples began speaking in different languages. The main message for the disciples was to go out and spread the Good News. That is our mission today as Catholics.

Student Attendance

Uniform

All students are expected to be in the correct full winter uniform. This includes a tie for boys and girls. If your child has lost a jacket, please come and check lost property located in the cupboard outside Year 5/library.

School Fees

Term 2 school fees are now due. If you haven't already finalised your account for Term 2 we ask if you could please make payment, thank you to all families that have finalised their account already.

The notice can be given any time during term for the next term and where appropriate notice has been received a pro-rata credit will be calculated. Where a term's notice has not been given to the Principal the terms school fees will be charged for your child/children.

Winter uniform is now available to order via the Quickcliq App. All students should now be in full winter uniform.




Thank you for your support in sending your child to school everyday in the correct uniform. Uniform orders will be sent home via your child on a Tuesday afternoon.
